



FLU ALERT

Influenza is a serious respiratory illness that spreads easily from person to person. Everyone is at risk of contracting influenza. Regular hand washing, covering your cough and sneeze and getting a yearly flu shot is the best protection against this potentially deadly disease.

The publicly funded seasonal influenza vaccine will be available, **free of charge**, through public health clinics and physicians **to any individual who wants to receive it.** Pharmacies can immunize those over the age of 9 years.

Public Health Nurses will be offering influenza immunizations at the **Parent Teacher conferences on Nov.** 8th at École Vicker's Public School, 3:30-8:30pm. Please feel free to bring the whole family! Please bring your health care card and wear short sleeves.






PEDESTRIAN SAFETY



Our parking lots are out of bounds for students. We urge parents to support us in this safety endeavor by dropping off their children on the west side of the school on Olive Diefenbaker Drive; on Bradbury Drive, east of the Special Needs bus zone and between Gisi Road and Olive Diefenbaker Drive.
