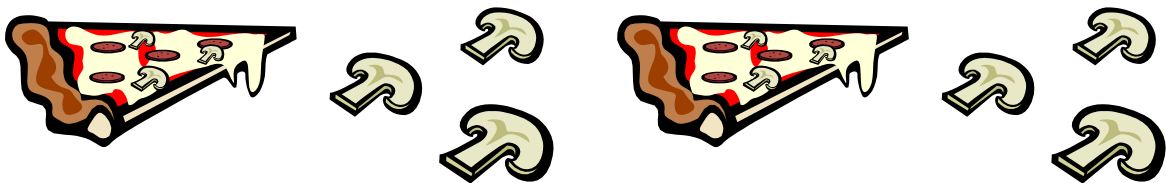

École Vickers Public School Kindergarten to Grade Four & Dev Ed Christmas Concert Information

This year the annual École Vickers Public School Christmas Concert will occur on Wednesday, December 20th. The concert will be held at the beautiful E.A. Rawlinson Centre for the Arts.

We will hold two performances. The first will occur at 12:30 p.m. and the second at 7:00 p.m. We will provide bussing for the students to and from the afternoon performance and request that parents provide transportation to and from the evening performance. Please have your child/ren at the Rawlinson Centre by 6:30 p.m. for the evening performance. Doors open at 12:00 for the afternoon performance and 6:30 for the evening performance.

The maximum audience size per performance is 600, so we will be selling tickets at the school beginning Monday, December 4th for \$2.00 per ticket. Each family will be allowed to purchase 2 tickets for the afternoon performance and 2 tickets for the evening performance. Please purchase tickets from your youngest/only child's homeroom teacher. The proceeds are used to offset the rental costs of the facility and the bussing of the students for the afternoon performance. Please note that the tickets are not seat specific, so seating will be first come/first served when the house opens at 12:00 for the afternoon performance and 6:30 for the evening performance.

INCLEMENT WEATHER



For the most part, we want our students to enjoy playing outdoors before school, during both recesses, and the noon hour. On rainy days, we allow students to come into the school upon their arrival and remain indoors during all breaks. In the winter, we use -30 degrees Celsius as our cut off to remain indoors. If the temperature and/or wind-chill in combination with the temperature exceed -30, then all students are permitted in the school in the morning and during break times. **We do expect that all students be dressed appropriately for the weather, as there are many cold days that students are expected to be outdoors.**

PEDESTRIAN SAFETY

Our parking lots are out of bounds for students. We urge parents to support us in this safety endeavor by dropping off their children on the west side of the school on Olive Diefenbaker Drive; on Bradbury Drive, east of the Special Needs bus zone and between Gisi Road and Olive Diefenbaker Drive. We encourage the children to cross all streets in a safe manner by crossing at the corner or at cross walks.



Teacher supervision is also provided at our major crosswalks. The Community Club rink parking lot is the bus pick up zone after school for our French Immersion busses, and a convenient place for French Immersion parents to meet their children for pick up.

We must respect the residents that border the school. Please refrain from turning around in driveways, as this is disruptive to the homeowners.
