### **INCLEMENT WEATHER**

Dear parent,

The end of the 2017-18 school year will mark the completion of the implementation of Saskatchewan Rivers Public School Division's French Immersion Enhancement Plan. In 2018-19, both École Vickers Public School and Arthur Pechey Public School will offer complete French Immersion programming from kindergarten to grade eight.

Attendance areas are in place to determine which French Immersion school will be the designated school for residents of Prince Albert and area. The attendance boundaries are defined as such:

- All eligible urban French Immersion students living on the east side of 6<sup>th</sup> Avenue East will attend École Vickers Public School.
- All eligible rural French Immersion students living in the East Central Public School or Osborne Public School attendance areas will attend École Vickers Public school.
- All other students living outside the above-mentioned areas will attend Arthur Pechey Public School.

To facilitate the transition process for families, an accommodation was made to our transportation procedures. It was decided that transportation would be provided to childcare centres that were not in the attendance area of a student's designated French Immersion school as defined by the above-mentioned attendance boundaries. Our communications to parents stated that this accommodation would be reviewed during the 2017-18 school year.

The review of the transportation accommodation is now complete. It has been decided that the accommodation will be lifted and regular transportation procedures will be applied in 2018-19. The result of this decision is that transportation will no longer be provided to a childcare centre that is outside of the attendance boundaries of a family's designated French Immersion school. Transportation will be provided to a childcare centre if both the childcare centre and the family's principal residence are within the attendance boundaries of the family's designated French Immersion school.

#### PEDESTRIAN SAFETY

Our parking lots are out of bounds for students. We urge parents to support us in this safety endeavor by dropping off their children on the west side of the school on Olive Diefenbaker Drive; on Bradbury Drive, east of the Special Needs bus zone and between Gisi Road and Olive Diefenbaker Drive.
