EXPECTATIONS

This is not a holiday. You will be acting *in loco parentis* for the entire duration of the trip. Do not expect to have 'down time' or time to yourself. You will need to be positive, warm, and encouraging to all students - particularly to those students who are quiet. A kind word to each student is expected.

NOTE: All trips are alcohol-free and tobacco-free. While some organizations allow chaperones to have a glass of wine with a meal, or when back at the hotel (once the children are asleep), we have an absolute ban on alcohol consumption of any kind – at all times. Tobacco use of any kind is strictly prohibited. The use of profanity is unacceptable.

Your responsibilities will/may include:

- Wake-up calls
- Ironing uniforms
- Administering medication
- Ensuring students maintain appropriate personal hygiene [brushing teeth, washing hair, changing clothes, etc]
- Ensuring students have their daypacks and materials required for each day
- Administering spending money
- Arranging for telephone calls home
- Frequent conversations with each student to ensure that concerns do not develop into problems
- Assistance with behaviour and manners
- Assistance packing luggage
- Ensuring the group is organized and on-time
- Ensuring all students are accounted for at all times
- Being in charge of Roll Call
- Always positioning yourself in the midst of the students to avoid a cluster of chaperones
- Official group photographer
- Administer first-aid.
- Hotel room checks
- 'Good Night' routine with the Directors
- Etc.

Chaperones will take turns being on **wake-up duty** [as early as 7:00a.m.] and being on **late-night supervision** [hallway supervision until 2:00a.m.]. You will expect to be up very late and awake very early.

BEHAVIOUR PROBLEMS:

All behaviour concerns will be shared with the Teacher and Head Chaperone, immediately. The Teacher will involve the Principal if necessary. The Director(s) will contact the parent(s)/guardian(s) if necessary. Chaperones will have meetings with the Directors in advance of our departure to organize responsibilities and duties of each Chaperone.
