For the most part, we want our students to enjoy playing outdoors before school, during both recesses, and the noon hour. 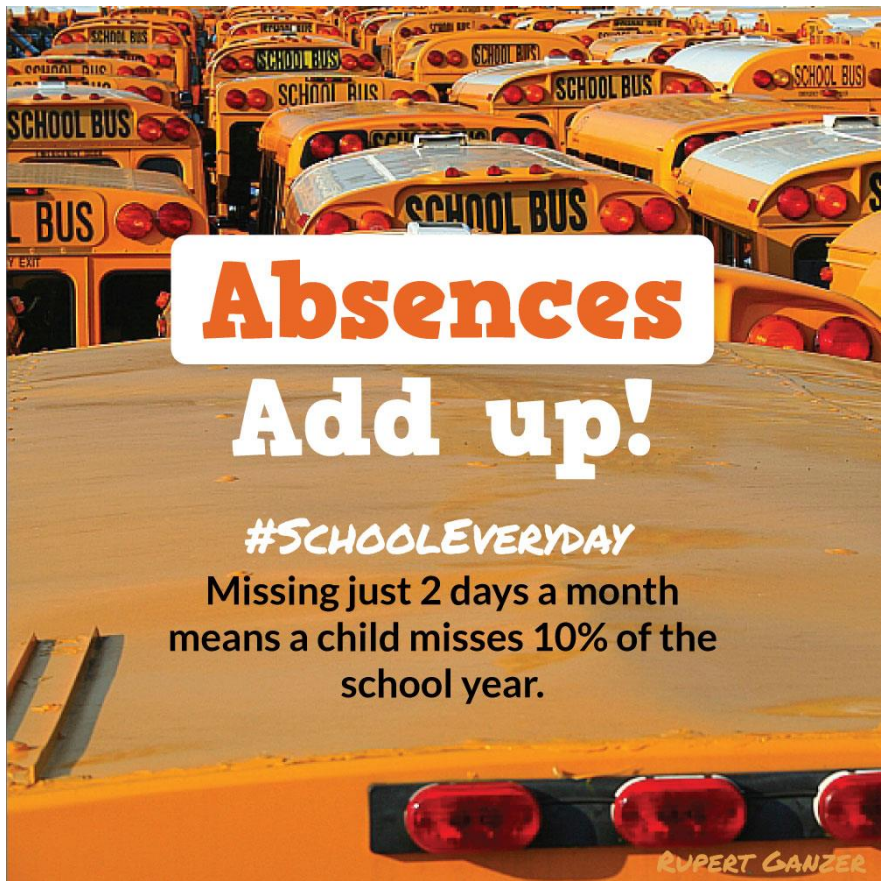


## PEDESTRIAN SAFETY
