École Vickers Public School Picture Day

Picture Day is fast approaching for the 2021-22 school year. Our school picture day will again run over two days this year, **Monday, September 27 and Tuesday, September 28** (schedules to follow). Proofs will come a few weeks after Picture Day and will distributed to each student to take home and order pictures. There will be two ways to order pictures;

1- Return the paper envelop to school with payment by the given date. Shipping will be free as long as envelops are returned by the designated day written on the envelop and picture orders will be delivered to the school.

2- Order online following the instructions provided on the proofs package. Shipping will be free and picture orders will be delivered to the school, as long as, the order is placed within the first 40 days after the proofs have been handed out. If the order is placed after the first 40 days, you will have to pay shipping fees and the picture will be shipped to your home address rather than the school.

If you child misses Picture Day or needs re-takes there will be a re-take day on **Thursday, October 28**. Lifetouch has notified the school that if you child needs re-take pictures they will likely not be able to distribute pictures before Christmas break.

INCLEMENT WEATHER

For the most part, we want our students to enjoy playing outdoors before school, during both recesses, and the noon hour. On rainy days, we allow students to come into the school upon their arrival and remain indoors during all breaks. In the winter, we use -30 degrees Celsius as our cut off to remain indoors. If the temperature and/or wind-chill in combination with the temperature exceed -30, then all students are permitted in the school in the morning and during break times. We do expect that all students be dressed appropriately for the weather, as there are many cold days that students are expected to be outdoors.



Our staff parking lots are a "no drop off zone" as they are out of bounds for students. We urge parents to support us in this safety endeavor by dropping off your children on the west side of the school on Olive Diefenbaker Drive; on Bradbury Drive, east of the Special Needs bus zone and between Gisi Road and Olive Diefenbaker Drive. We encourage the children to cross all streets in a safe manner by crossing at the corner or at cross walks. Teacher supervision is also provided at our major crosswalks. The Community Club rink parking lot is the bus pick up zone after school for our French Immersion busses, and a convenient place for French Immersion parents to meet their children for pick up.

We ask that you, please, respect the residents that border the school. Please refrain from turning around in or blocking neighboring driveways, as this is disruptive to the homeowners.

One other item of note, please remember that there have been changes made to the Traffic Bylaw which now prohibits U-turns in school zones. In an effort to improve the safety of our children, the City of Prince Albert has added this safety measure. There is a \$100 fine for violating this restriction.

Our Vickers' school zone is between Bradbury Drive and Olive Diefenbaker Drive.
