

SCHOOL ACTIVITY FEE

If you have not paid your child's School Activity Fees please do so at the office.

This fee is collected to assist in covering the costs of optional activities or events that would enhance the regular school programming and would enrich the education of participating students. Some examples of these are out of school educational experiences, activities, presentations and/or speakers. The fee is \$10.00 for kindergarten and \$20.00 for Gr 1-8 & Dev Ed.

INCLEMENT WEATHER

For the most part, we want our students to enjoy playing outdoors before school, during both recesses, and the noon hour. On rainy days, we allow students to come into the school upon their arrival and remain indoors during all breaks. In the winter, we use -30 degrees Celsius as our cut off to remain indoors. If the temperature and/or wind-chill in combination with the temperature exceed -30, then all students are permitted in the school in the morning and during break times. We do expect that all students be dressed appropriately for the weather, as there are many cold days that students are expected to be outdoors.





PEDESTRIAN SAFETY

Our staff parking lots are a "no drop off zone" as they are out of bounds for students. We urge parents to support us in this safety endeavor by dropping off your children on the west side of the school on Olive Diefenbaker Drive; on Bradbury Drive, east of the Special Needs bus zone and between Gisi Road and Olive Diefenbaker Drive. We encourage the children to cross all streets in a safe manner by crossing at the corner or at cross walks. Teacher supervision is also provided at our major crosswalks. The Community Club rink parking lot is the bus pick up zone after school for our French Immersion busses, and a convenient place for French Immersion parents to meet their children for pick up.

We ask that you, please, respect the residents that border the school. Please refrain from turning around in or blocking neighboring driveways, as this is disruptive to the homeowners.

One other item of note, please remember that there have been changes made to the Traffic Bylaw which now prohibits U-turns in school zones. In an effort to improve the safety of our children, the City of Prince Albert has added this safety measure. There is a \$100 fine for violating this restriction.

Our Vickers' school zone is between Bradbury Drive and Olive Diefenbaker Drive.

Vickers Pollinator Garden Project

<u>By Grade 4 Klein</u>

We will be growing in the Vickers Outdoor Classroom raised garden beds and at a part of the rotary trail near the ball diamond by the pond. All students at Vickers will be invited to participate.



We are planting a pollinator garden for pollinators like bees, hummingbirds, and butterflies to help them because there are not enough flowers for them. Our entire school is helping. We will teach older and younger students to be respectful to our garden to look and smell. We know that

bats don't pollinate but they do eat the insects that are pollinators so this is for bats too!

Vegetables we will grow are squash, tomatoes, cucumbers, beans, pumpkins, peas, corn, and carrots. Other flowers will be cosmos, marigolds, sunflowers, sweet peas, gaillardia, harebell, milkweed, black eyed susan, aster, goldenrod, yarrow, and more. Trees will be Saskatoons, apples and others. Trees will give homes, shade and wind protection.

Without pollination, we would not have much food nor would animals. We will be using mulch because it will save the water from the plants. We will not use pesticides because it will poison the plants. We are also planting a garden because it takes in carbon dioxide which reduces greenhouse gasses.
