PRINCIPAL CORNER

Many of you know that we are a math goal school. This is our third year working on this goal. Our staff has read the book, *Building Thinking Classrooms in Mathematics*, which provides several ideas and strategies to excel in math. One of our strategies is using non-permanent vertical surfaces to problem



solve on. This is a great way for students to get up and talk and think about math. When students work on these surfaces, they are focused on the "math thinking" without the risk of getting the wrong answer – this greatly reduces math anxiety.
